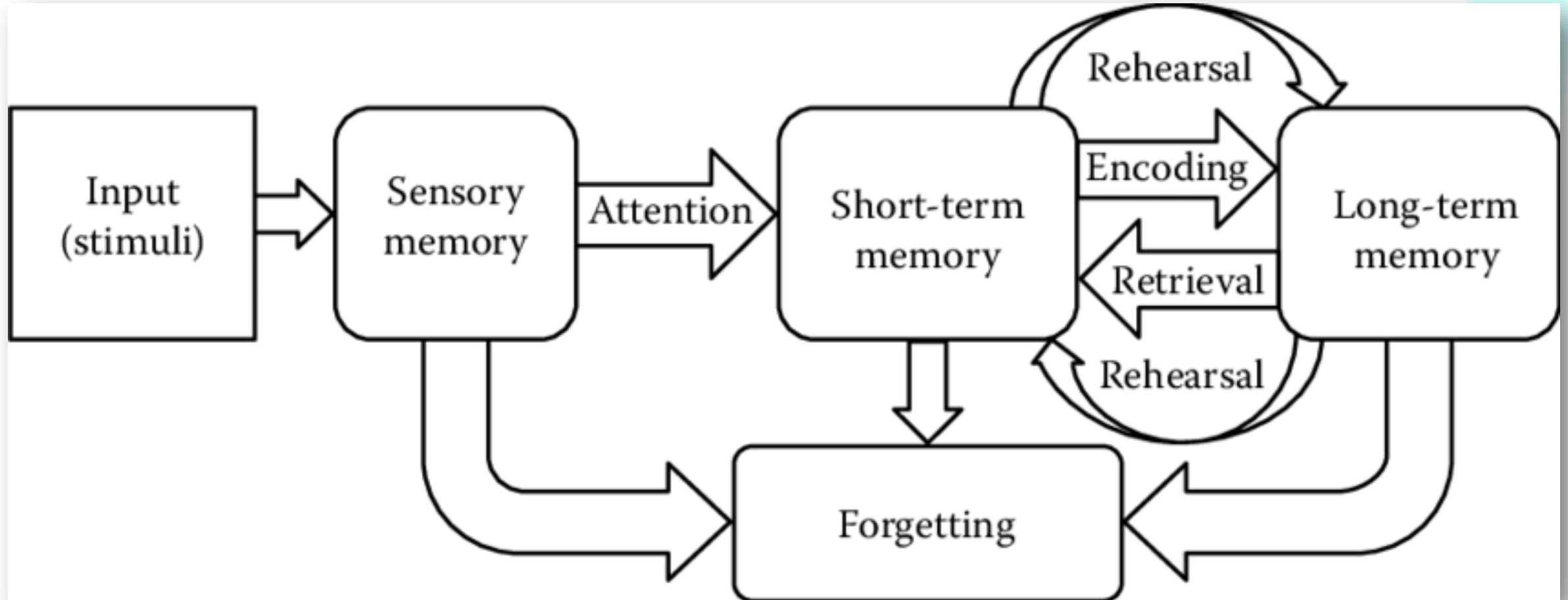
All students must secure a 4 or above in
