Upcoming Highway Works in Caister

Please find useful information below regarding upcoming highway works in Caister from Persimmon Homes:

- **Mon 29 September - Fri 14 November - Foul Water Connection** - Works on the A149 dual carriageway northbound, will include one lane closure for the above dates to construct the new foul water sewer to West Road. All traffic management will be removed by Friday 14 November. The hours of work are 7.30am – 6.00pm.
- **Mon 17 November - Fri 28 November - New Footway/Cycleway Connection** - Works on the western end of Norwich Road (northern side) to continue the footpath from its current position towards the junction with Prince of Wales Road. This will mean that no traffic will be able to enter Norwich Road from the roundabout junction of A149/Norwich Road/Jack Chase Way. Traffic will be able to leave Norwich Road and enter the roundabout of A149/Norwich Road/Jack Chase Way. The hours of work are 7.30am – 6.00pm.
